RoHS Policy Statement

The legal responsibility for ensuring that end products that are subject to the RoHS Directive meet the regulations lies with the manufacturer of those products, where these are manufactured in the EU / UK.

Where parts are manufactured outside of the EU / UK then the legal responsibility rests with the importer of that product into the EU / UK.

Customers expect their Suppliers to give them accurate information about RoHS compliance for the components they purchase.

As a Distributor of electrical and electronic equipment Aerco obtain statements from the Original Equipment / Component Manufacturers concerning their products' conformance to RoHS. This information is to the best of Aerco's knowledge at that point of time; where Aerco cannot determine the RoHS status, it shall be marked as "RoHS Unknown – Check With Manufacturer".

Aerco are unable to complete individual questionnaires, spreadsheets and declarations of material composition although will supply copies manufacturers statements it holds upon request. The RoHS status is identified on Aerco's Certificate of Conformity / Advice Note.
